



**NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**Notifications to Cairnryan Port Services**

In addition to Cairnryan NtM 02/2017, The Master of every vessel which

- has been involved in a collision with any vessel, navigational mark, shore facility or property; or
- by reason of fire, defect or otherwise is in such a condition as to affect its safe navigation or to give rise to danger or damage to other vessels or property; or
- as been involved in any incident or occurrence which causes or threatens contamination or pollution of the environment by any means;
- has been involved in grounding in any part of the Authority's Area;

will as soon as reasonably practicable report the occurrence to the Harbour Master and as soon as reasonably practicable thereafter provide the Harbour Master with full details in writing.

- Where the damage to a vessel is such that it affects, or is likely to affect, her seaworthiness, the Master will not, other than with the permission of the Harbour Master and in accordance with his directions move the vessel except to a clear a fairway, or to moor, or anchor in safety.

Mariners are reminded that notifying Cairnryan Port Services is equivalent to notifying the Harbour Master.
