

By Sea:


Adjacent to the main shipping lanes through the North Channel.
Short pilotage; less than 2nm from pilot station to berth

By Road:

A8 Dual carriage way runs right to port's main entrance

Storage in the port




- Total Quayside storage 9000sqm

- Further land available for development adjacent to the port




Perfect for project cargoes
